"Loose and Juicy Citscapes" will be the theme for this workshop. This workshop will cover equally the steps of design, drawing, and painting. Participants will learn to create strong compositions, execute a solid underlying sketch, and draw and paint buildings, effectively. Expect to learn while having fun through demonstration, exercises, and individual instruction and encouragement.

Day 1: Painting exercises. Participants will never be scared by the prospect of painting people and buildings again.

Day 2: Spend the day painting a cityscape.

We recommend that you attend both days of the workshop, but each workshop is set up each day as an individual lesson.

Students can use a reference photo taken by the instructor or bring their own. Artists will supply their own materials. (Material list will be provided)
